## Financial audit report

### Audit opinion on the project financial statement

#### Unmodified opinion

We have audited the accompanying project financial statement for the project 'Procurement of Goods and Services for Restoration of Ukraine' ("the project") (oneUNOPS project ID 23842-001), which is implemented and managed by the UNOPS Office in Ukraine, for the period from 26 November 2022 to 31 December 2024.

In our opinion, the financial statement gives a true and fair view of, in all material respects, the income and expenditure of the project 'Procurement of Goods and Services for Restoration of Ukraine' ("the project") (oneUNOPS project ID 23842-001), for the period from 26 November 2022 to 31 December 2024 in conformity with the terms of the agreements and in accordance with International Public Sector Accounting Standards.

#### Basis for opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with International Standards on Auditing (ISAs). Our responsibilities under those provisions and standards are further described in the 'Auditor's responsibility for the audit of the project financial statement' section of this report.

We are independent of UNOPS in accordance with the IESBA Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants. We have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

#### Management responsibility for the financial statement

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statement in accordance with International Public Sector Accounting Standards, and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation of a financial statement that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

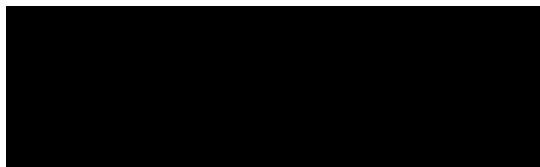
