Dear Ms. Faremo,

I hereby acknowledge receipt of your letter dated May 19, 2015, with regards to which I, on behalf of the Government of Grenada, wish to confirm the following:

- 1. That the terms of the Standard Basic Assistance Agreement between the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and the Government of Grenada concluded on 17 May 1976 will apply mutatis mutandis, to the personnel, activities, property and assets of the UNOPS Office in Grenada.
- 2. That in applying the UNDP Agreement, mutatis mutandis, we confirm that the treatment afforded to UNOPS shall be no less favourable than the one afforded to any accredited foreign mission or international organization in Grenada.
- 3. That the Government of Grenada shall provide to UNOPS and its personnel, such security as is required for the effective performance of its activities. In this regard, the Convention on the Privileges and Immunities of the United Nations to which Grenada is a party shall apply to the UNOPS Office in Grenada, its premises, property, funds and assets as well to its personnel and their official activities in Grenada.

4. That this letter of confirmation constitutes an Agreement between the United Nations and the Government of Grenada, entered into force today, regulating matters relating to, and arising out of, the establishment and proper functioning of the UNOPS Office in Grenada.
